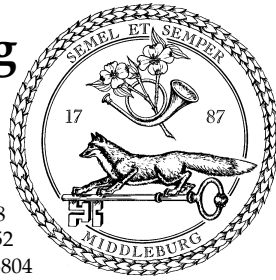

From our Town Planner/Zoning Administrator, David Beniamino:

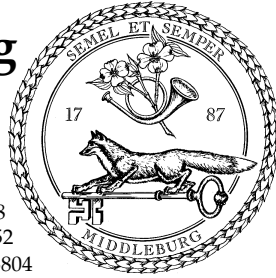
Salamander Resort & Spa

The Middleburg Town Council is considering candidates for appointment to Town Committees. The following Committees have appointment terms ranging from one to five-year appointments:

Historic District Review Committee (HDRC): The HDRC reviews applications for development within the Historic District; considers appropriateness of changes or alteration of contributing sites/structures within a Historic District; and may request initiation of study of a proposed Historic District. Membership is open, but not limited, to town residents.

Individuals with certain professional expertise related to historic preservation that are not Town residents may also serve on the Committee in accordance with the Middleburg HDRC Bylaws. Committee Members are appointed by the Town Council. Monthly meetings: 1st Thursday, 5:30 PM.

Board of Zoning Appeals (BZA): Local zoning regulations provide controls for specific land uses in designated areas of Town. Citizens who seek exceptions to those regulations or disagree with the Town's enforcement ask the BZA to hear their case. Membership is open to Town residents and appointments are made by the Circuit Court upon recommendation of the Town Council. Meetings are scheduled as needed.
